Alice and William Henry Roberts, a fellow missionary working in the Kachin State, marry. The Roberts establish a mission, church, and school in Bamaw.

The Roberts retire and return to the US in 1917.

William Henry Roberts passes away.

Alice Roberts, her son William Henry Roberts, Jr. and his wife, move to Redlands where they become members of The First Baptist Church of Redlands.

Alice Roberts is active in the Women's Missionary Society and church life until her death.
